



Project Healthy Outcomes Through Prevention and Early Support (HOPES) programs offer a variety of family-centered services in their communities including home visitation. When selecting services for a family, HOPES providers work together with the family to determine the services that best meet their needs. Some of the results for families that participate in Project HOPES include: improved family relationships, increased feeling of support, increased knowledge of child development, and increased knowledge of parenting techniques. To be eligible for Project HOPES, parents/caregivers must have at least one child age 0-5, or be expecting a child. In addition, parents/caregivers must reside in one of the eight counties listed below. Services are provided at no cost to families who qualify for the HOPES program.
